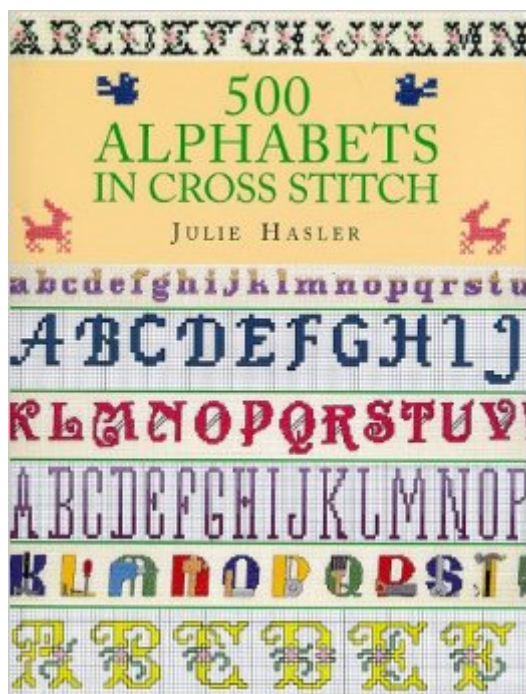

I was not impressed when I bought this book as it actually does not contain 500 Alphabets, in fact there are about 90. There are some numbers from 0-9, not enough to make up the other 410 designs though (and a set of numbers is not an alphabet). I know that Julie Hasler has done a series of '500' books, but the title clearly states that there are *500* Alphabets in Cross Stitch. Apart from the small fact that there are 400-odd missing it's not a bad book. I think this is a breach of the Fair Trading Act, the commerce commission should do these people! If anyone can explain how 90 and 500 are related, I'd love to know!

I see why the other reviewer complained about the shortage of alphabets, and can only surmise they were counting letters, not whole alphabets when they created the hyperbolic title. While I would have liked more charts, I imagine that cramming 500 alphabets into one book would make it at least

500 pages long--or micrographically small charts, so I'm content with the number of variations. The charts themselves are large enough to read easily, well colored, and simple to follow. Because of the specific craft I'm using them for--loom-beaded straps--I'd appreciate knowing how many rows high each alphabet runs, but it's a simple matter to count the squares. This gives me a decent starting point, and I can add variations on my own.
