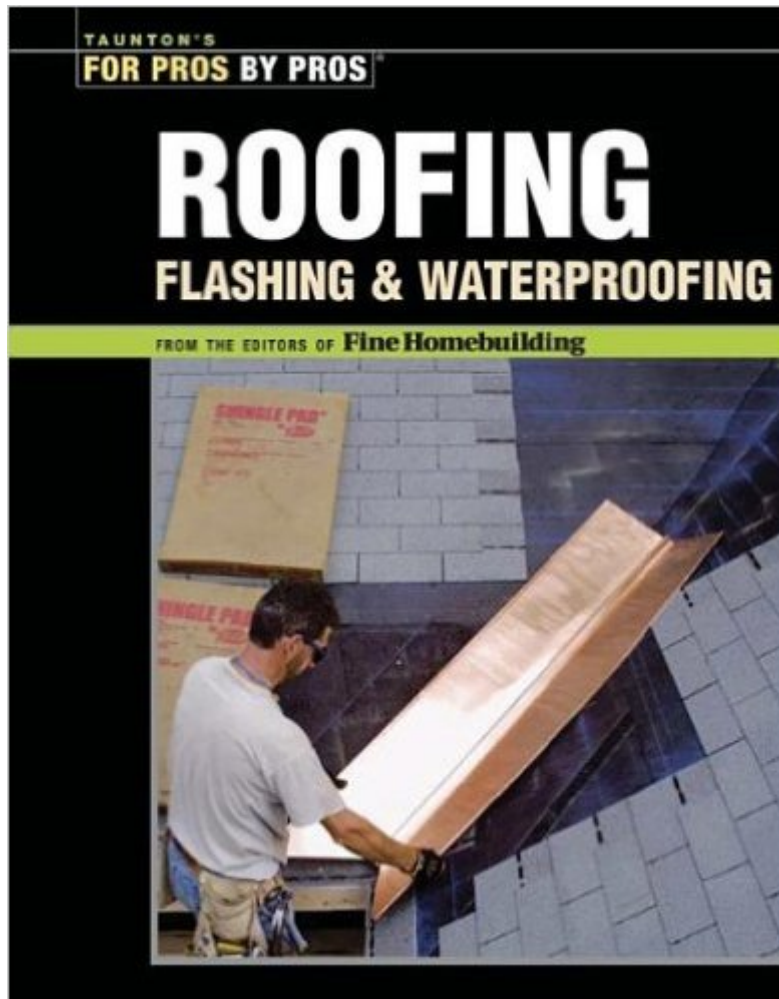

series. It is informative, detailed and good reading. I had my roofing replaced eight years ago and I wish I had read this book then. This book would have given me the knowledge to correctly select materials, emphasize specific procedures, oversee the work knowledgeably and to finally inspect the completed work. This is great information to have for a few dollars when considering a \$5000-\$8000 roofing job.

I was a little disappointed with the quality of this book. It is more a book of opinions than a book of current facts and directions on how to do it right. I have been in the business for over 20 years and found several problems with what it says. It sounds like it was the work of only one person instead of a group of professionals.

Focusing mainly on carpentry lately, I wanted to "brush up" on my flashing techniques. Taunton's books are very informative and well written.
